- Moving away from Adobe Reader. Will take some time, projected completion date unknown
- Moving towards 1 format for audio and ebook--will eliminate need to order multiple audio/ebook formats
- Completely new interface, moving away from the clunky digital media console
- "See book, get book", users will be able to store their preferred devices online. When they login, system will recognize preferences and show titles that are compatible with their preferred device only.
- Simultaneous access ebooks--will be adding significantly more titles
- Kindles will be compatible by year-end
- Samples for all ebooks will be available by year-end
- OverDrive WIN program will allow patrons to recommend titles for purchase
- Content Reserve will have a total makeover--more Amazon like
- Dashboard is an enhancement that can be downloaded at no cost and will facilitate gathering and viewing stats

Recorded Books

- One Click Digital^{re} launched July
- Audiobooks only- ebooks to come early 2012
- Sold as Core Collections and individual titles
- Multiple user access on titles
- No longer using NetLibrary interface, much cleaner, easier interface
- \$241,000 for Adult and Children Core Collections
- \$180,000 for Adult only
- Zinio- Magazine subscription service, will work on flash enabled devices, streaming online- not downloadable, 4000 titles

EBSCO eBooks

- Shared collections going away, replaced with one book=one user, one book=3 users, or one book=unlimited users models
- Subscription model, which includes patron driven acquisition model in which a collection is loaded into our catalog and after two hits on a title, that title is automatically purchased.
- EBSCO will look into possibility of linking WPLC titles to BadgerLink
