

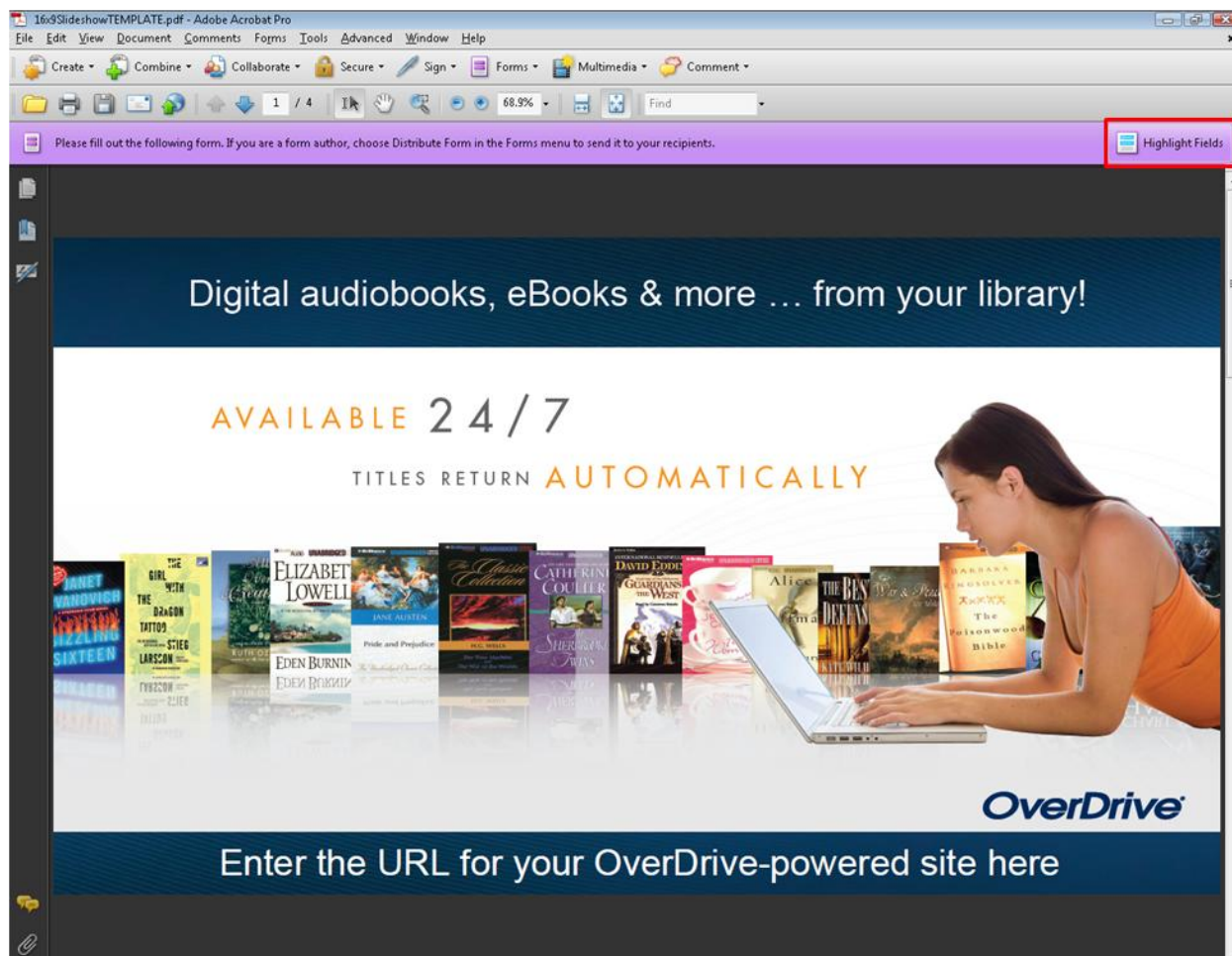
How to Build an OverDrive Slideshow for your Library

using Adobe Acrobat

Create a looping slideshow to display on monitors around your library highlighting your OverDrive service, plus customize the presentation with the URL for your library's Virtual Branch. Adobe Acrobat is required to customize this slideshow. If you need assistance in customizing the slideshow for your library or consortium, please email training@overdrive.com.

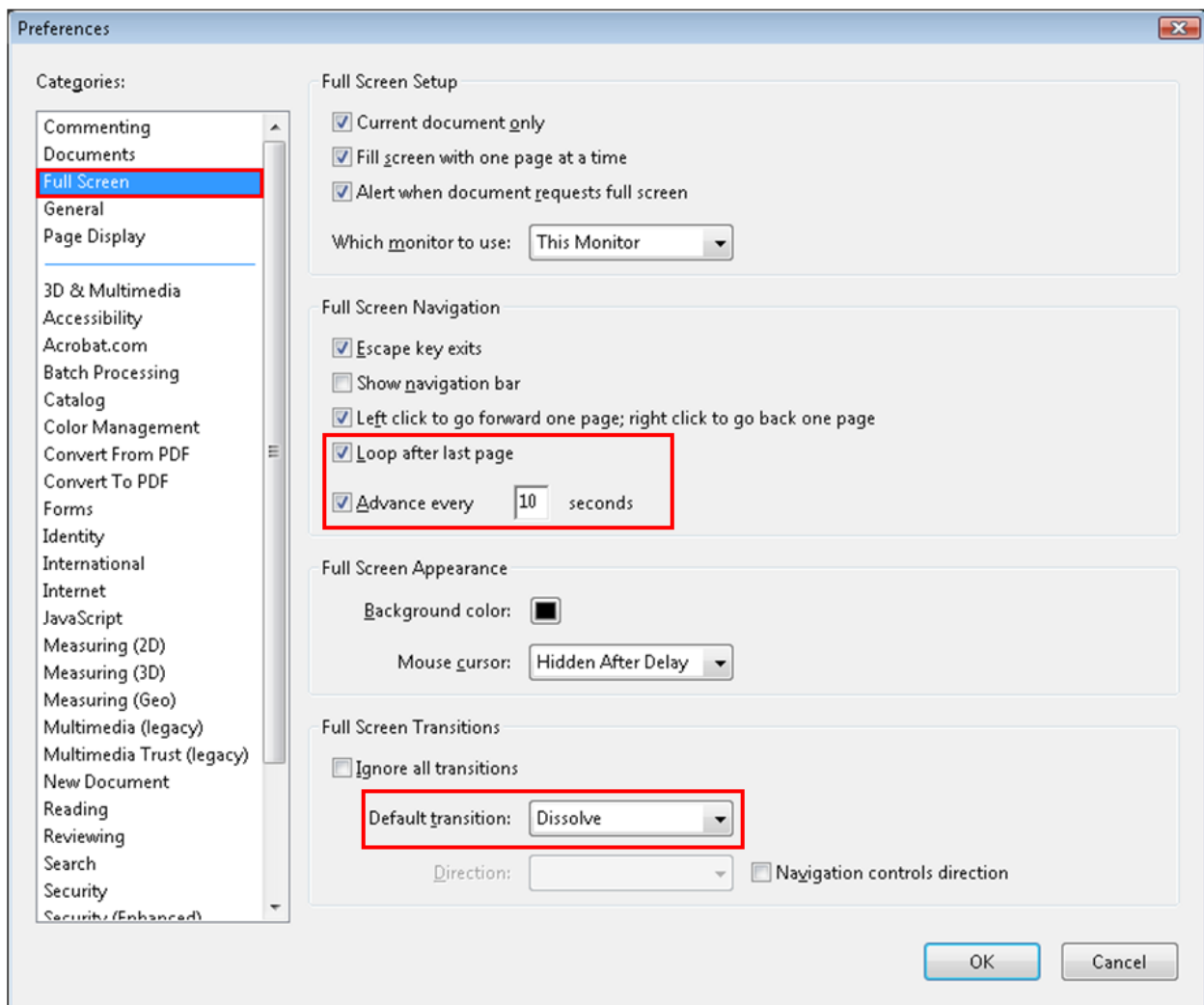
Step 1: Customize PDF.

1. Open the PDF in Adobe Acrobat.
2. Enter your library's or consortium's Virtual Branch website address in the editable field at the bottom of the PDF.
3. If the editable field is highlighted, turn off highlighting by selecting the 'Highlight Fields' option in the upper right hand corner.



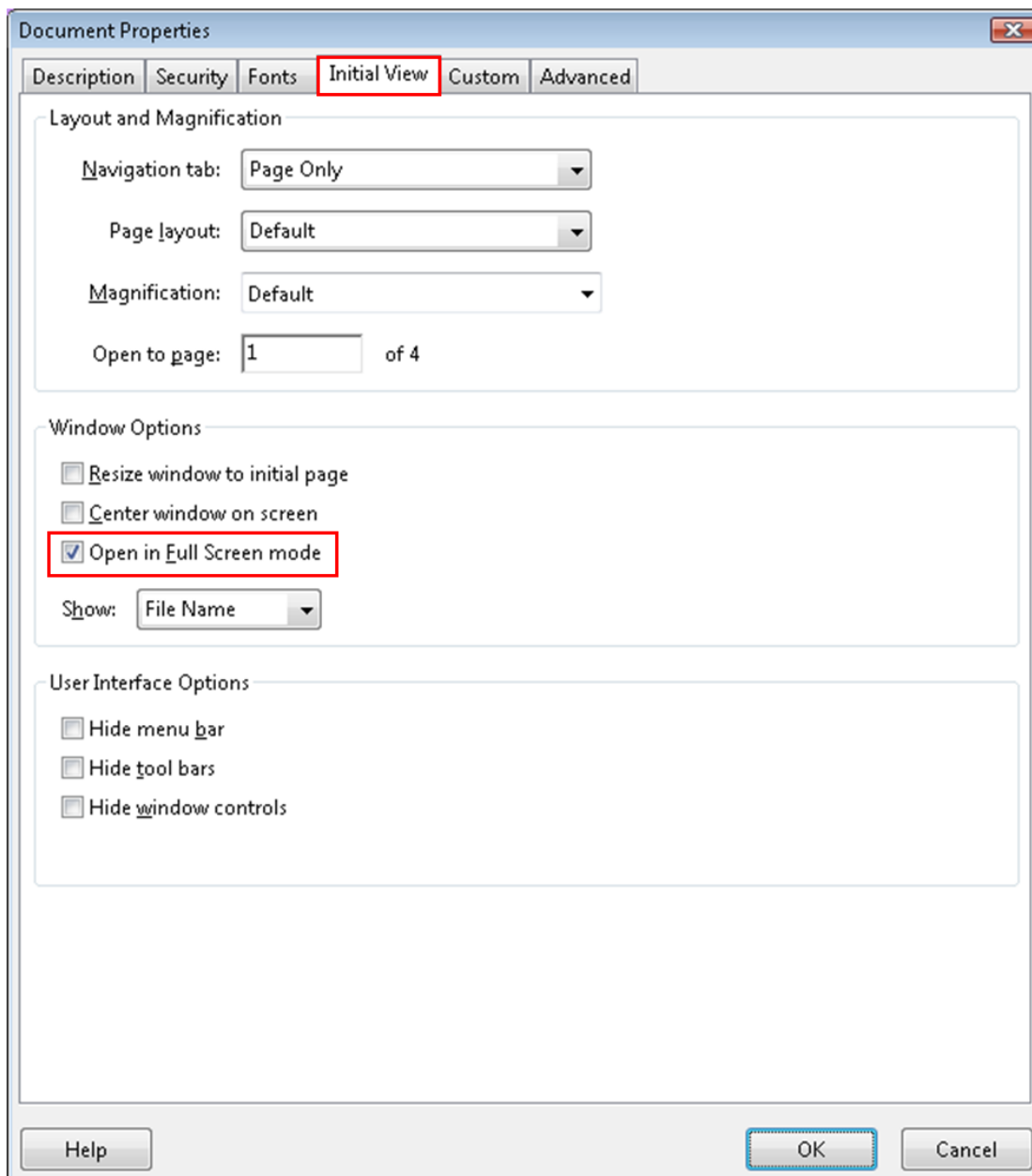
Step 2: Set Acrobat's Full Screen Preferences.

1. With the PDF open, go to:
 - Windows computer: *Edit > Preferences.*
 - Mac computer: *Acrobat > Preferences.*
2. From the Categories panel, select 'Full Screen'.
 - **Loop after last page:** Check this option to keep your slideshow looping indefinitely.
 - **Advance every __ seconds:** This sets how long each slide pauses before transitioning to the next page.
 - **Default transition:** This setting adjusts how your pages transition.



Step 3: Set your document to open in Full Screen mode.

1. With the PDF open, go to *File > Properties*.
(or 'Document Properties' in some versions of Acrobat).
2. In the Document Properties window, click on the Initial View tab.
3. Check the **Open in Full Screen mode** checkbox.
4. Click 'OK'.



Step 4: Save and close PDF.

1. With the PDF open, go to *File > Save As...*
2. Save the customized PDF.
3. The next time the PDF is opened, it will open to full screen and loop automatically.
