


## Differences when we upgrade to the 3.9 client

### Standby

#### 3.2 client


- closes all applications and effectively logs the user off, "holding" their slot for them
- requires library card AND pin to resume session
- shows clock

#### 3.9 client

- leaves applications open and effectively "locks the desktop" (nice!)
- requires only PIN to resume session
- does not show clock



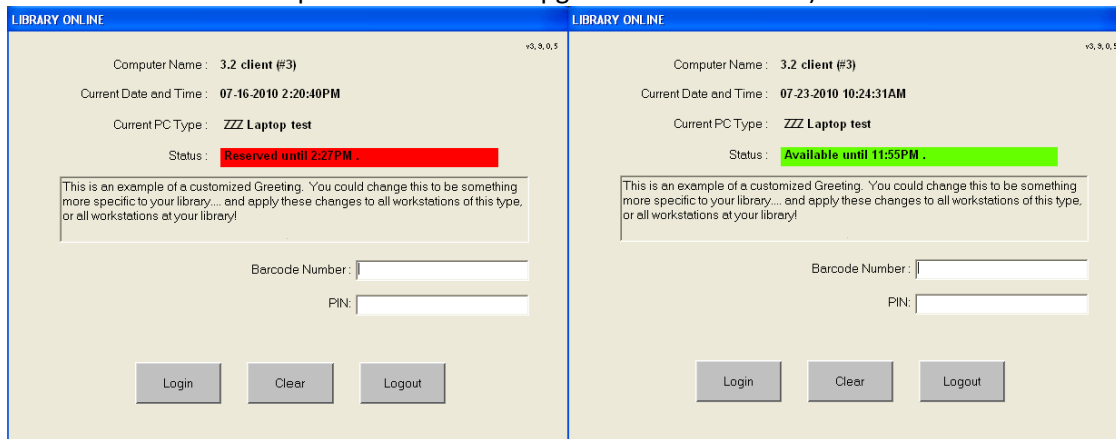

Notes: The current warning for user entering in Standby is a SYSTEM setting and warns the user that all applications will be closed (not true with the 3.9 client!). This will be changed to more accurately reflect 3.9 client behavior only after ALL clients are at 3.9.

## Show workstation status on the timeout client

To ease the process of identifying available (or booked) workstations the timeout client has been enhanced to provide a visible clue as to the status of the workstations availability. If a workstation is available the status section will be highlighted green. If workstation is not available it will be highlighted red.

**SCLS Notes:** True. Lime green for available. Red for unavailable. This is true ONLY on the 3.9 client (so will not take effect until public PCs are also upgraded to version 3.9).



## Setting in Branch Administration for “The number of minutes a patron must wait between walkup bookings for the same machine”

- 3.2 client ignores this setting
- 3.9 client uses this setting.

## Display of special characters in Workstation Type Description

- 3.2 - client incorrectly displays ampersands in Workstation Type Description as "&amp;" and apostrophes as "&apos;"
- 3.9 - client correctly displays ampersands and apostrophes
