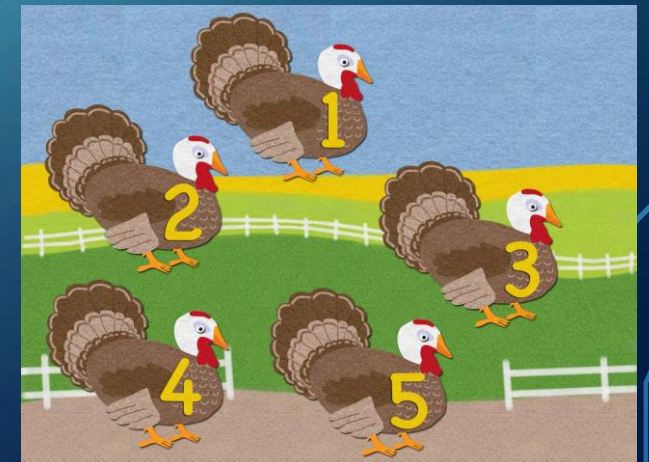
NEW MEDIA IN OUTREACH

- Pros

- Lightweight, portable
- Versatile (music, stories, storytime stretchers)
- Element of excitement and surprise
- Modeling for caregivers/providers

- Cons

- Sound – Bluetooth
- Size – best for small groups



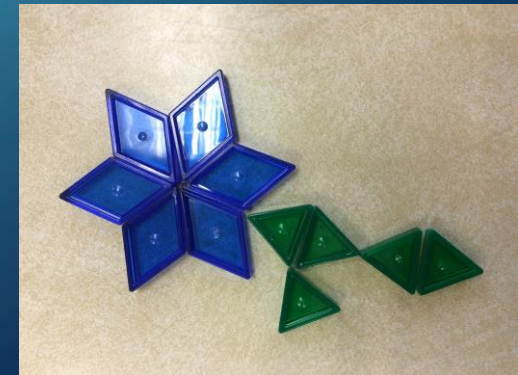
PLAY BASED PROGRAMS

- Pros

- Parent/Child Interaction
- Child plays for a short time and moves on to another station
- Models apps and Media Diet for families

- Cons

- Sometimes the kiddos do everything you don't want them to and it's time to either redirect or find another tool.



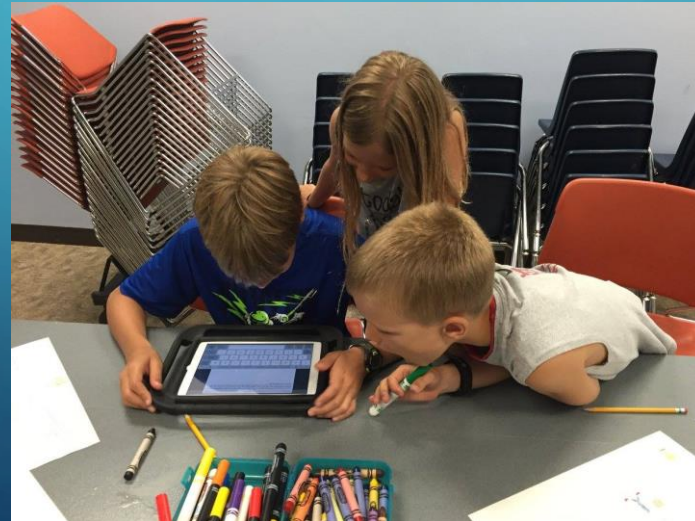
TWEEN SCENES

- Pros

- Encourages digital literacy skills

- Cons

- Working on social skills
- Technical difficulties
