Circulation

Holds incorrectly marked Hold Over on expiration date, not day after. The Holds Awaiting Pickup report was marking holds as Over without accounting for the library's calendar and closed dates. (SCLS Support Ticket #23092)

Circulation History (was Revision History) and Patron Edit History tables. Apparently trying to display records (staff, test) with a lot of entries was severely affecting server response and performance. The new update limits result sets to 500 of the most recent entries. (No SCLS Support Ticket Number)
