

**Bibliovation 7.02.38/39 Release Notes for Library Staff
January 30, 2024**

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General Notes

This upgrade includes enhancements and fixes that have been tested by SCLS staff and staff at some libraries. To the best of everyone’s assessment, the fixes are working well and any bugs identified during testing have been fixed. However, as we learned with past upgrades and patches, we may experience unexpected results following the upgrade. We may also discover new problems. Circulation

Some Holds Checked in not completing full actions: Sometimes when holds were checked in, the full range of actions were not performed. Hold slip was generated, patron had Holds Waiting message on Checkout screen and a Message was generated for the patron. But the item’s status in the item record would display as “Available” at the Check in location. This has been tested and was not able to be replicated in the Sandbox. (SCLS Support ticket #2402)

Last Seen date is displaying in UTC: Last Seen date was displaying in UTC, not Central time. Fixed. (SCLS Support ticket #2280)

Local Holds on Holds Queue report when “hold policy overridden”: System was ignoring the hold policy settings for Item Types with a “Home Holds” setting, allowing any hold request that had been placed using the staff ‘override’ permission. This has been PARTIALLY fixed; requests still may appear on your Holds Queue report but checking the item in will not trap the item for the hold if the pickup location is not your library. (SCLS Support ticket #2145)

Advance Notice of Item Due notices are reporting due date in UTC not CDT. Notices reported the due “time” as 5 hours prior to the end of the day. This has been fixed and the notices also only report the date, not the timestamp. (SCLS Support ticket #2327)

Items with Custom Item Statuses require two check-ins to trap for holds. Items with Custom Items statuses no longer require two check-ins to trap the items for holds. The status will be cleared and the item trapped for an eligible hold with only one check-in. (SCLS Support ticket #2899)
