

Our Door is open

The library will resume limited operations on Monday, June 1, with our summer hours Monday 9 am – noon and 1 pm – 5 pm, Tuesday and Thursday 1 pm – 5 pm, Wednesday 1 pm – 8 pm, and Saturday 9 am – noon. Taking guidance from the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction and WEDC we have made the necessary changes to protect our staff and patrons.

- We are limiting the number of patrons in the building to no more than 10 at this time.
- Hands must be washed or sanitized as you enter the building.
- Wearing a mask is encouraged, but not required at this time.
- We ask patrons to use library time for selecting materials and checking out, therefore reducing social time inside the building.
- Computer usage will be for research purposes and will have time restrictions.
- Some furniture has been removed to allow appropriate spacing of patrons.
- Curbside service will continue to be available upon request.
- No programs such as Story Hour, Lego Night, and Book Club until further notice.
- Items returned with either be sanitized or quarantined 72 hours before going back on the shelf.
- Interlibrary Loan is still not available.
- Library may close on short notice if there is a resurgence of the virus in our area or we find patrons not respecting our new guidelines.
