

- Plexiglass by checkout desk. Second door entering building is propped open.
- Only staff will be stamping books.
- Staff has to log computer users.
- Gloves must be worn when checking in materials and sorting for quarantine.
- 1 computer was disabled to allow social distancing.
- The goal is to not have kids using computers for non-essential purposes.
- All toys have been removed and covered.
- Bubbler will have a do not use sign on it. Dixie cups are available upon request to be filled in the bathroom.
- We are limiting the number of patrons in the building to no more than 10.
- Hands must be washed or sanitized as you enter the building.
- Wearing a mask is recommended, but not required at this time. (Staff and Patrons)
- We ask patrons to use library time for selecting materials and checking out, therefore reducing social time inside the building.
- Computer usage will be for research purposes and will have time restrictions (right now it is 1 hour).
- Some furniture has been removed to allow appropriate spacing of patrons.
- Curbside service will continue to be available upon request.
- No programs such as Story Hour, Lego Night, and Book Club until further notice.
- Summer Reading Program will run June 10 – July 29, with a few changes from past programs.
- Items returned with either be sanitized or quarantined 72 hours before going back on the shelf.
- Interlibrary Loan is still not available.
- Conference room is not available for public use.
- Staff has to sanitize after their shift all touching points (door knobs/handles, computers used, bathroom fixtures, light switches, sanitizer pumps, checkout desk counter).
- Library may close on short notice if there is a resurgence of the virus in our area or we find patrons not respecting our new guidelines.
