
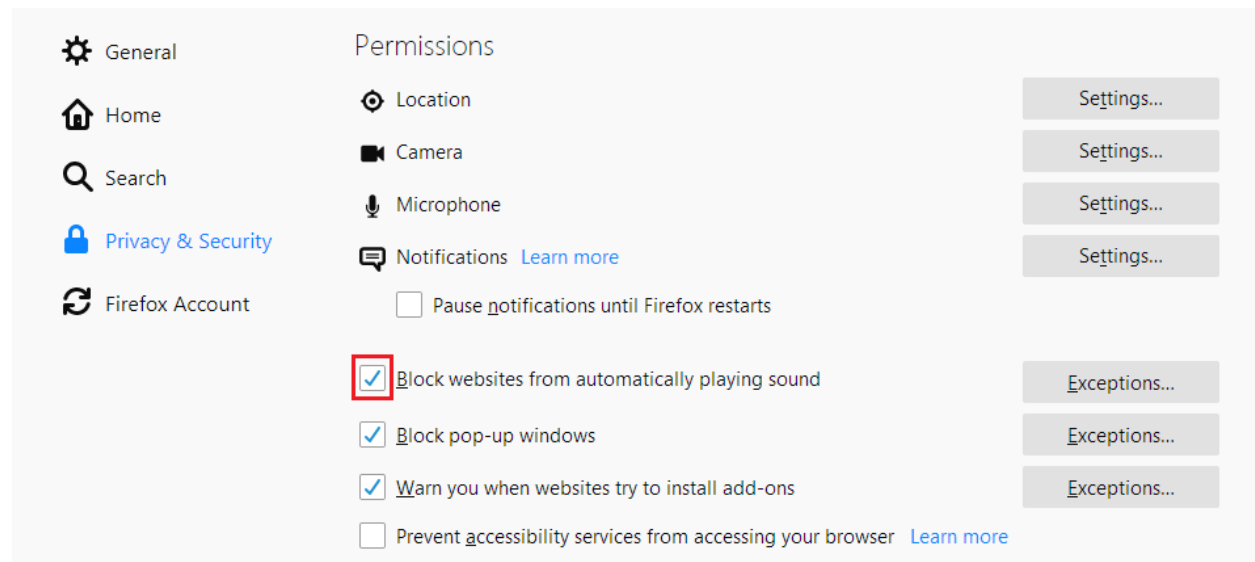


Allow Firefox to play Koha sounds:

The new version of Firefox has a setting to keep those websites that automatically play sounds (usually ads) from annoying you. Unfortunately that also blocks the Koha sounds. To unblock the Koha sounds:

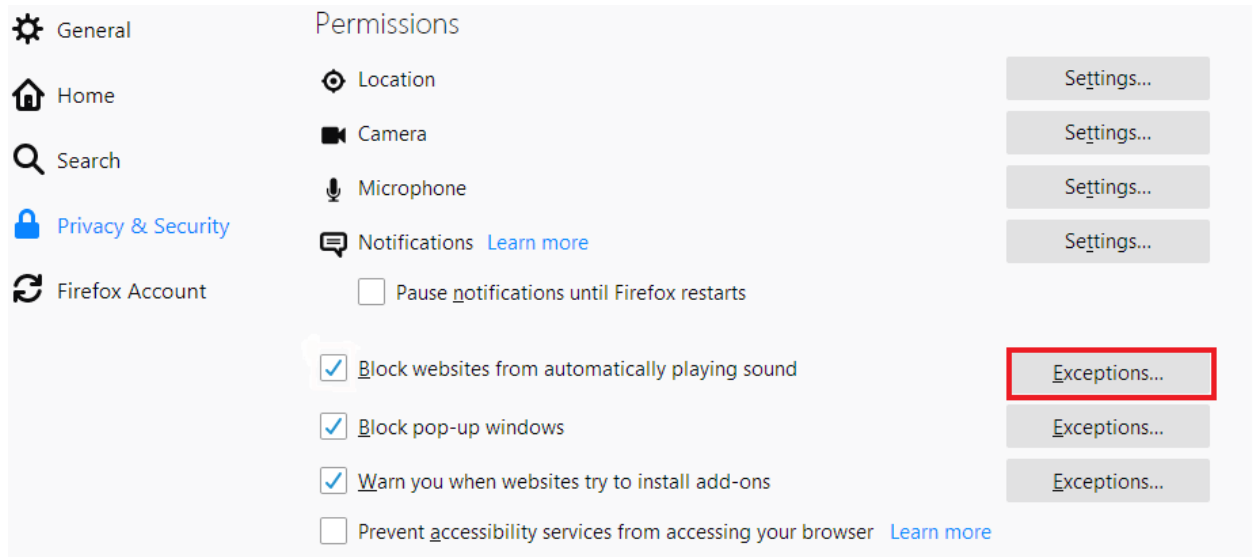
1. Click on the “hamburger” icon  at the top right of the Firefox window.
2. Choose **Options** from the drop down menu. This will open a new tab.
3. Select **Privacy & Security** from the menu on the left side.
4. Scroll down until you find the Permissions area.
5. Decide which option you want:
 - a. Unblock all websites which is quicker but allows any site to play noises. See step 6.
 - b. Do a couple of additional steps and unblock just for the Koha/Bibliovation related sites and leave the other sites blocked. See step 7.
6. **Unblock sounds for all websites:**
 - a. In the Permissions area, uncheck the option **Block websites from automatically playing sound**.



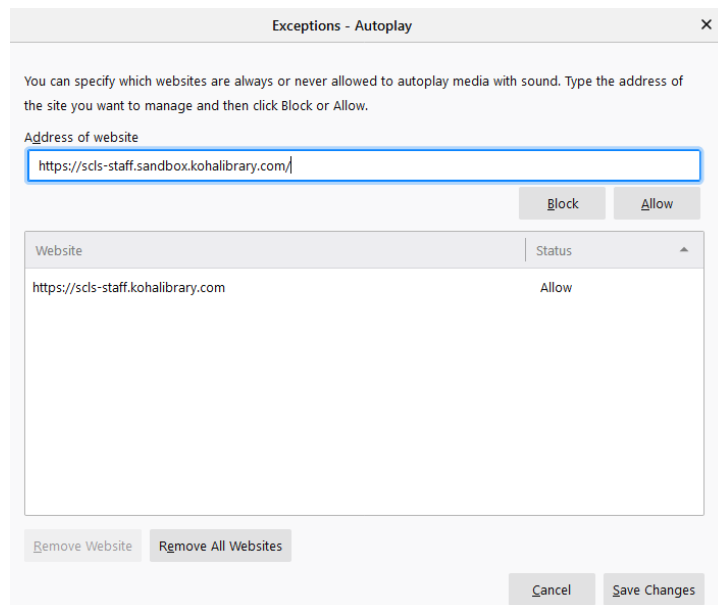
- b. Close the Options tab and reload your Firefox page.

7. **Unblock sounds just for Koha and Bibliovation websites:**

- a. In the Permissions area, find the option Block websites from automatically playing sound and click on the **Exceptions** button after it.



- b. Copy each of the addresses below into the **Address of the website** box and click **Allow**. (Only copy the part after "address: " as you'll need to do each address separately.)
- i. Koha address: `https://scls-staff.kohalibrary.com`
 - ii. Koha Sandbox address: `https://scls-staff.sandbox.kohalibrary.com/`
 - iii. Bibliovation Sandbox address: `https://lakscls-sandbox.bibliovation.com/`



- c. When all addresses have been entered, click on **Save changes**. This will close the Exceptions box.
- d. Close the Options tab and reload your Firefox page.
