1. How are you and your staff doing?  
They are anxious but excited about the new building. They had an 8% budget cut from the city which has been hard on them.
2. What are the next projects (big or small) on your library's to-do list?  
The biggest one is the library addition project. The addition should be done in May 2023 and then they will work on renovating the current library. They have also create a new organization chart/staffing structure which will take place starting 1/1/23. This will have more standardized titles, hours, and pay scales.
3. Are there service changes or new services from the last two years that you plan on continuing?  
They still do curbside pickup. They also got lockers via a grant. In the new building they will have a pickup window for “curbside” pickup.
4. How can SCLS help?  
We talked a lot about technology in the new building, mainly what I can help with as far as setting things up and the Wi-Fi access points.

They are pretty excited about the new sorter coming in the new building.
