

McMillan Library to re-open June 15

McMillan Memorial Library will open to the public on Monday, June 15th. This limited reopening uses the White House Opening Up America guidelines. All materials will be available for checkout but some services and features will be limited.

McMillan will be open from 9:00 am to 6:00 pm Monday through Friday. Following advice from public health experts, the McMillan Coffeehouse will remain closed. Much of the seating and tables are in temporary storage. Public computers will not be available at this time, though Wi-Fi will be expanded to cover the parking lot. Curbside and grab bag service will continue to be provided.

As always, disruptive behavior will not be tolerated and children under the age of 8 must be attended by a responsible caregiver at all times. Physical distancing is strongly encouraged for patrons, as are masks. Patrons are reminded that bringing their library card makes checkout faster and safer.
