

## Grab-n-Go: Beginning Readers-Robots

### READ

***Robot, Go Bot!*** by Dana Meachen Rau; illustrated by Wook Jin Jung

Help your child find the joy in reading, by encouraging them to practice reading independently!

### LISTEN & READ TOGETHER

***Meet the Dinotrux*** by Chris Gall

Let your child develop a love for reading, by reading fun and engaging stories together! Listen to Wonderbooks at home or on the road, with headphones or aloud! Listen to the story and “read” what’s happening in the pictures!

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### EARLY BEGINNING READERS: TALK AND PLAY TOGETHER

Always make time for guided play! Creative exploration and play are how children learn self-regulation, problem-solving, teamwork, and communication! Build with Legos, modeling clay, or recyclable materials! Can you build a tower with straws and newspaper? Can you build a Minecraft friend out of Legos? Try creating robots, dinosaurs, or people with modeling clay!

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### BEGINNING READERS: WRITE AND DRAW TOGETHER

Encourage your child to talk about and/or write as much or as little as your child is comfortable with!

Prompt: *If you were friends with a real robot, what would it look like? What is its name? What would you like to do together?*

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
