Bibliovation 7.00.21 point release upgrade

A Bibliovation upgrade took place on Tuesday, September 13 after 9pm. The fixes in this upgrade only affected sorters. <u>Please see the release notes</u> for information on the sorter fixes.

Bibliovation 7.2 upgrade

LibLime added a new point release upgrade to the sandbox during the week of September 26. This release did contain a number of important bugfixes. SCLS staff are working through the testing for these fixes, and there continue to be outstanding bugs that must be resolved before we can upgrade production. Rio and Marshfield bibliographic record cleanup

SCLS staff and the Madison Catalogers continue to work on bibliographic record cleanup for the Marshfield and Rio migrated bibliographic records. We are continuing to merge any duplicates and provide OCLC cataloging when needed.

CSS is recommending the addition of another item type for this project – DVDSETJ14, for juvenile TV series.

The ARPA funded holds lockers were installed in all 8 participating libraries this week. There were a few "hiccups", but overall the process went smoothly.
