Pros:

- Made in the USA
- 3-year warranty
- Rugged, designed to be moved around
- Windows 11 is offered
- Other software is optional
- The shipping crate appears to have wheels

Cons:

- Used ones sell for around \$10,000.00
- Heavy, 130+ lbs without the shipping crate
- Moving something of this size may be an issue
 - Would require a delivery van with a lift gate.
