JUNE 28

- BadgerNet goes down late in the date (after 3 pm)
- Madison Public Library and Monona Public Library will not be down (MUFN)
- No internet at any other SCLS network services library
- Greater chance of restoring network services early
- Will not do if can't happen late in the day

JUNE 29-JULY I

- No INTERNET in any SCLS network library (including Wi-Fi)
- Talking Tech goes down
- Self-checks will not work
- Bibliovation is available with internet service (including for patrons)
- Most databases are available with internet service (including for patrons)

JUNE 29

- MUFN & WiscNet go down
- Dell moves network equipment
- Begin reconnecting networks

JUNE 30-JULY I

- Reconnection of network services continues
- Restoration of Talking Tech

CHECKOUT ON BIBLIOVATION

- All LINKcat libraries can use Offline Circulation to check out without Internet
- Test ahead of time—Heidi Oliversen will help

FULL ACCESS TO BIBLIOVATION (WITH INTERNET)

- Includes Checkin
- Available to:
 - Libraries not on SCLS network
 - Libraries with alternate network (wireless)
 - Mobile hotspot
- Cannot put SCLS supported PCs on non-SCLS network

ALTERNATIVE SOLUTIONS

- Mobile hotspot + laptop + barcode scanner
 - Access to Internet
 - Full access to Bibliovation—can checkin and checkout
 - Can't print receipts (unless have a USB printer)
 - Email
 - Status wiki for updates

ALTERNATIVE SOLUTIONS

- Mobile hotspot + desktop
 - More complicated, but it is possible—library will need to be able to set up and support with some assistance from SCLS

SCLS CAN...

- Lend some laptops and barcode scanners
- Lend RFID tagging stations which will allow checkin and checkout of RFID tagged materials
- Help with procuring hotspots
- Will create a form to identify need
