# **ILS Report June 2023**

## Bibliovation 7.02.35 point release upgrade

A Bibliovation point release took place on June 27 at 9pm. This upgrade fixed some new bugs introduced in the 7.02 upgrade, as well as some older bugs. Please see the <u>release notes</u> for a full list of fixes.

## SCLS network services will not be available between Wednesday, June 28 (afternoon) - and Saturday,

July 1, 2023, while SCLS moves network services to its new building. This means that libraries that use SCLS as its Internet Services Provider will be without access to the Internet. In addition, other SCLS services will not be available due to the cutover. Follow this <u>link</u> for a list of service availability. Bibliovation, LINKcat and some databases will be available remotely, or with alternate internet access in libraries. We have a team available to help you prepare for the cutover. We thank you for your patience and understanding during this service outage and we look forward to serving you from our <u>new headquarters</u>. We will be sending out information on options for the cutover soon.

# LINKcat Mobile App connectivity

SCLS staff met with Solus at ALA Annual. Solus will continue to work on resolving the app connectivity problems. After those problems are resolved, we will begin testing an app redesign. SCLS staff and some library staff saw a demo of the newly-redesigned app at ALA Annual.

# Marshfield bibliographic record cleanup

We are continuing to work through MFD records. One of the Cataloging Assistant LTEs (Stefanie) is working on this project.

# **OverDrive API Integration**

The API integration will allow patrons to check OverDrive title availability information from LINKcat. SCLS staff are continuing to follow up with LibLime on the status of this project.

# **Local Holds Pilot Project**

Local Holds is now an ongoing workflow for those libraries that want to provide that service option for their patrons. The ILS Committee sunsetted the workgroup at their June 7 meeting.

## Reports

- Reports have been updated for the changes in Bibliovation 7.02.
  - The 7.02 upgrade fixed the issues with the renewal statistics so the Daily Overview and Daily Hourly report are now able to be run daily again instead of having to be run once a week.
  - The upgrade also fixed the issue with the selfcheck transactions being recorded in UTC instead of Central Time and not being labeled as selfcheck transactions. So the hourly reports should now be accurate and show the selfcheck transactions with a location/other code of SIP-1.
- A bug that prevented Withdrawn items with fees from being deleted during monthly batch deletions was fixed in the 7.02 upgrade. LibLime staff batch-deleted those items for us in Production after SCLS staff confirmed the fix. SCLS staff ran the "May" Annual Batch deletion reports in June and posted them on the Reports webpage for libraries to review. We will

schedule the annual purge/archiving of data for the end of July/early August as work schedules permit.

- The last issue with the selfchecks was fixed before the 7.02 upgrade. No new issues with the selfchecks have been reported since the upgrade.
- Baraboo's sorter was installed.

## Authority Control and Database Maintenance

May 2023 Authority Control/Batch Deletes

- 16,804 items and 1,798 bibliographic records (with only withdrawn items attached) were deleted in the monthly batch deletion of withdrawn items.
- 4,097 bibliographic records were newly cataloged and/or updated in the database between 6/1/2023 and 6/27/2023.
