Discussion

- a. Firefox browser problems: At the April Technology committee, SCLS discussed not adding Firefox to windows 10 patron computers because it was not compatible and everyone agreed to that. Firefox is still on windows 7 and 8 patron computers. Firefox released a new version, which is now named Firefox Quantum. SCLS has been controlling Firefox on windows 7 and 8 patron computers, but the Firefox Quantum is no longer compatible with the SCLS

management tools. An example is that if a new tab is opened in Firefox, the new tab is blank and you can't do anything with it. The tech team took a look at this and determined that it would take hours to fix with no guarantee that it would work. SCLS recommends removing Firefox from Windows 7 & 8 on the patron side, but would like a discussion before any action is taken. Other options are available such as Edge, Chrome and Internet Explorer as web browsers. The tech committee agreed that because of the issues with Firefox, SCLS should proceed with removing it. Firefox will remain on all staff computers.
